MINUTES GENERAL MEETING, MARCH 8, 2016 (revised)

- 1. Thirty-two neighbors attended the meeting.
- Minutes from the previous General Meeting on October 15, 2015, were approved.
- 3. Treasurer Debbie Darr reported the LCA is currently behind on membership dues. As of now, the dues are not covering expenses. Total liabilities and equity stands at \$22,186,35 The budget was approved.
- 4. Communications chair Molly White reported the newsletter just went out. She encouraged everyone to read it on listserv and the LCA website, although she may have to resort to snail mail to make sure everyone gets it. Molly said the next newsletter will go out before the May general meeting. She said she needs a two and a half week window to get articles in the newsletter, and she does accept pictures.
- 5. Hospitality chair Christine Tennies asked everyone to let her know about new neighbors. She also passed out vacation forms residents can fill out and give to police, who will check on houses three times a day. People can also contact the Cockeysville Precinct for forms as well.
- 6. Marie Frederick, membership chair, said we now have a total of 220 paid members. Membership dues total \$3,435.00, that's down by \$827.00 from this time last year. As for

- nominating matters, Marie said these positions will be open for voting at the May General Meeting: Two members-at-large, hospitality, and history. Marie asked people to let her know if they or anyone they know would be interested in the positions. Molly said she would put the information on the LCA website.
- 7. Public facilities and Zoning chair Eric Rockel arrived late. President Julie Szymaszek reported that while off-track betting at Timonium Fairgrounds got preliminary approval, both county councilman Wade Kach and state representative Chris West are introducing bills to prevent a casino or slots at the racetrack. As for College Manor, the 4-year agreement on development is almost up. Residents should contact Wade Kach about their wishes concerning what happens after that. The ongoing improvements on Riderwood Drive are part of the new plan to keep the land as open space. Councilman Wade Kach is proposing a "neighborhood commons" designation for part of Roland Run, which would not be open to development. It's in the flood plain anyway. Owners of a property at the corner of Norman and Bellona avenues want to change zoning to 10.5, so they can build townhouses. They plan to present their plans to the LCA board at the next meeting. The former site of Watson's garden center will be developed as a strip mall approximately the same size as the

garden center. There will still be a buffer in back of the property, and storm water will drain onto York Road. Resident Ernie Shea complained about storm water and sewer problems on Melancthon Avenue, saying the Lutherville Fire House renovation is the cause, and it will only get worse when the LVFD paves over an adjoining lot for parking. Neighbors have joined forces to solicit help from the county, and is asking for LCA support. The LCA continues to ask county officials for help cleaning up the garbage-strewn path between the Lutherville light rail station and Country Club Park. The county wants the community to do it. Eric said he'll look into it and solicit volunteers to do it ourselves. Two other zoning issues are imminent: Variances to build a house on an under-sized lot on Morris Avenue, and another plea to the board of appeals to prevent the Luthervilla project from going through.

- 8. Security chair John Alexander said police want to remind people not to leave their car keys in their cars, and to be sure to lock their cars.
- 9. Debbie Darr reported for the Special Events committee that the Easter Egg hunt is on March 20th, the Sunday before Easter. She asked people with children to drop off a dozen eggs and to help hide them. Debbie said we need a new

- Special Events chair, and it could be split into adult and children's events.
- 10. House Tour Chair Marcia Hettinger reported she needs more committee people to help plan for the tour in October of 2017. The goal is to have 10 to 12 houses, and to attract from 700 to 1,500 people. The next meeting is on April 5th at St. Paul's Church.
- 11. Traffic chair Jeff Dier said he's been working on speed signs on Kurtz and Francke avenues, and will need to canvas residents to get their opinions. There's a traffic committee meeting on March 23th at Spangler Hall, and Jeff urged committee members to attend, since attendance has dropped significantly. Jeff also reported on efforts to get the sign at Lutherville Crossing removed because it interferes with drivers' lines of sight. Also, Jeff said he took action to have the intersection at Bellona and Seminary avenues cleaned up after recent drainage work.

The meeting was adjourned.
