## TRAFFIC STOP

You may have seen “Drive Like Your Kids Live Here” signs popping up in our neighborhood recently. As part of LCA’s never-ending quest to slow the speed of cut-through traffic in our community, we have purchased several sets of yard signs and “safety kids” and distributed them to the four corners of Lutherville. Each set includes two red and white yard signs and one plastic yellow “safety kid.” County Traffic and Engineering has advised to display the signs for a month or two at a time in the spring and fall. Our plan is to rotate the signs among several neighbors. If you are interested in having a set of the signs in your yard or sharing a set with a neighbor, please let me know.
